### Genesis 2:4-17 NASB

<sup>4</sup> This is the account of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made earth and heaven. <sup>5</sup> Now no shrub of the field was yet on the earth, and no plant of the field had yet sprouted, for the LORD God had not sent rain upon the earth, and there was no man to cultivate the ground. <sup>6</sup> But a mist used to rise from the earth and water the whole surface of the ground. <sup>7</sup> Then the LORD God formed the man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and the man became a living person. 8 The LORD God planted a garden toward the east, in Eden; and there He placed the man whom He had formed. 9 Out of the ground the LORD God caused every tree to grow that is pleasing to the sight and good for food; the tree of life was also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

And the fourth river is the Euphrates.

<sup>15</sup> Then the LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to cultivate it and tend it. <sup>16</sup> The LORD God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may freely eat; <sup>17</sup> but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for on the day that you eat from it you will certainly die."
